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1. INTRODUCTION

This document aprovides the definition of a Shipment Status Message, based on the ANSI X12 version 004010, to be used in Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) between Dollar General and its carrier.

All segments in the subset used by Dollar General are described in the following pages. The segment description is to be read as follows:

Unless otherwise specified in the field explanation in the documentation, dates are always expressed as **CCYYMDD** (qualifier 2379 = 102).

Times –

Unless otherwise specified in the field explanation in the documentation, times are always expressed as $\ensuremath{\mathsf{HHMM}}$.



AT7-01 and AT7-03 are mutually exclusive. If you need to communicate both a shipment status code and a shipment appointment status code, it must be done in two separate AT7 segments. Only send LT – Local Time of the event or location. If AT7-01 is communicated then the AT7-02 must be communicated as well. If AT7-03 is communicated then the AT7-04 must be communicated as well. Dollar General Corporation is not requesting any messages other than Normal Appointment or Normal Status. Therefore, the AT7-02 should contain NS (Normal Status) or the AT7-04 should contain NA (Normal Appointment).
